## **!!! PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION CAREFULLY and STRICTLY OBSERVE THEM !!!**

### Your child's safety :

This cot has been produced in compliance with the European standard DIN EN 716.  
All safety-relevant product characteristics are designed for one child:

- Durability of lath floor and sides
- Durability of screw connections
- Height of bars as anti-climbers

**Please do not use the cot as play area for two or more children  
!!! Risk of accident !!!**

**WARNING:** Do not leave anything in the bed that the child may use to climb on or that may carry the risk of suffocation or strangulation.

**WARNING:** Do not use the bed if any of the individual parts are damaged or lost!

**WARNING:** The bed should not be placed in the vicinity of open fire or other strong sources of heat, such as electrical radiant heaters, gas furnaces, etc.

**WARNING:** Never use more than one mattress in the child bed.

- Two adults are needed for the assembly of this product.
- The lowest slatted frame position is the safest for your child and only this position should be used once the child is old enough to sit up.
- The thickness of the mattress must be selected such that the distance between the mattress surface and the top of the bed frame is at least 50 cm in the lowest position of the slatted frame (bed base) and at least 20 cm in the highest position of the slatted frame.
- The red line on the inner side of the head- or footboard indicates the highest allowed mattress height.
- The mattress size depends upon the bed size and should accordingly be 70x140 cm.
- One of the bed sides has 2 or 3 removable side bars. For the safety of your child, this side should be assembled such so that the side bars can be removed only by lifting them up. Mounting the bed side the other way around is absolutely not allowed and can lead to accidents.
- The general condition of the bed should be regularly checked, while paying special attention to safety!
- All fittings for assembly must always be appropriately mounted.  
Screws should not be loose, since a child can get caught or pieces of clothing (such as string, collars or pacifier bands) can get stuck on them.  
Apart from that, there is the danger of strangulation.
- Use a screwdriver to tighten the threaded plugs.
- The assembly screws must be checked and tightened if necessary.
- To avoid danger of suffocation, each plastic casing must be removed before use.
- Clean the product with natural soap suds to protect the material.
- Although during production of our furniture we use only varnishes that are not harmful to one's health, we ask that you air the product well for a few days, to remove the new product smell.
- To avoid falls: do not use the bed once the child can climb out of it.
